Race #1: Kingsbury Grade **May 17, 2009** **Minden, NV**
7.9 miles, 2550' elevation gain, 6.1% average grade. Course record: 35:01 (Max Polin)

Parking, registration, and start at corner of Foothill Rd. and Kingsbury Grade.
Registration opens at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 9:45 a.m. **First rider off at 10:00 a.m.**

Race #2: 6 Mile Canyon **June 28, 2009** **Virginia City, NV**
5.82 miles, 1642' elevation gain, 5.3% average grade. Course record: 23:32 (Max Polin).

Parking and registration at Ramada Hotel, 100 E St., Virginia City. Ride down to start.
Registration opens at 7:30 a.m. and closes at 8:45 a.m. **First rider off at 9:00 a.m.**

Race #3: Geiger Grade **July 19, 2009** **Reno, NV**
7.64 miles, 2126' elevation gain, 5.3% average grade. Course record: 29:25 (Bobby Julich)

Parking, registration, and start at Foothill Market, corner of Kivett Ln. and Geiger Grade, Reno
Registration opens at 7:30 a.m. and closes at 8:45 a.m. **First rider off at 9:00 a.m.**

Race #4: Mt. Rose **August 9, 2009** **Reno, NV**
13.7 miles, 3715' elevation gain, 5.1% average grade. Course record: 54:50 (Kyle Dixon)
Course map: <http://www.gmap-pedometer.com/?r=1786735>. **Race Weighting: 7**
Parking, registration, and start at Galena Market, 19990 Thomas Creek Road, Reno
Registration opens at 6:00 a.m. and closes at 7:15 a.m. **First rider off at 7:30 a.m.**

Registration: Registration for each event is day-of (no late fees, no field limits). Fill out a USA Cycling release form and bring to each race (http://www.usacycling.org/forms/rider_release.pdf).
Entry fee for each race is \$20. USCF License required. One-day licenses available.
Riders will be given start times at registration, and will be started in order of registration.

Categories: Open Men, Open Women, Master Men (35+), Master Women (35+), Juniors (under 18)

Prizes: This is a four-race, points-based series. Points are awarded at each race (10 for 1st, 9 for 2nd, 1 for 10th and below) and multiplied by the race weighting to determine overall score.
Riders must race at least 3 races, including Mt. Rose, to qualify for overall prizes.

Race Prizes: Top 3 in each category will receive cash and/or merchandise.

Course Record Prize: \$100 to the rider setting a new course record at any race.

Overall Prizes: Top 3 in each category will receive cash (min. \$80/60/40) and merchandise.
